

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Excelsior Springs intends to apply for CDBG funds to assist with an industrial expansion. The maximum grant amount available is \$2 million to support improvement of public works and others as allowed by law. The National objective is to benefit low-to-moderate income individuals with an opportunity for employment.

There will not be displacement of persons resulting from the project. The city is soliciting citizen input on the city's on-going community development needs. The proposed project for which the city is applying will improve the intersection of Corum Road & St. Louis Ave. and improve the approach to the railroad crossing on S. McCleary Road.

The total estimated project costs will not exceed \$480,000, the amount being applied for will not exceed \$400,000, local funds proposed will not exceed \$80,000. LMI benefit of the proposed project will be at least 51%. **Area residents are encouraged to attend the public hearing to be held at the Hall of Waters, City Council Chambers, on Thursday, March 28th at 4:30pm.**

Attendees may request language interpretation to assist with their participation, the location of the meeting is accessible to persons with physical disabilities, attendees can request reasonable accommodations to participate in the meeting.
